Gary would like the position of Webmaster to be incorporated into the Constitution of the CDCA as an officer, to be elected annually, and this will be brought forward to the next meeting. Gary tendered his resignation, but we were all very relieved when he said he would continue if voted back on - carried unanimously!!
