Re: Two Headed Man traffic signal junction

I refer to your letters dated 24th September and 24th October 2007.

I have been in discussions with our Traffic Signal unit about the feasibility of installing road markings within the junction, however with the road being less than 9m in width, they do not advise that right turn markings should be laid here.

To increase the road width at this junction would require land acquisition and construction costs, which may be high depending upon utilities and how much land and work is required, and this would need to be determined.

You are very aware of the difficulties that we have at present with our scheme budget and monies for this kind of work are not available. I have already noted the need to improve this junction on our Task Register and will be starting discussions with the landowner, the Duchy of Cornwall Office shortly.

In the meantime, I will write to the Duchy of Cornwall Office to ask them to keep the hedge trimmed low to improve visibility as requested.
